St. Michaels, Navajo Nation (AZ) - The Navajo Nation Human Rights Commission postpones January 8, 2015 public hearing in Flagstaff, Arizona until further notice.

NNHRC felt it necessary to postpone the Public Hearing on the treatment of Navajo citizens by law enforcement in border towns in respect of the recent events that involved the shooting of the late Officer Tyler Jacob Stewart of Flagstaff Police Department. The NNHRC sends out its sincere condolences to the family of Stewart.

Gallup, New Mexico public hearing will still commence this coming Wednesday, January 7, 2015 at the Gallup Community Service Center on 401 Bataan Veteran's Street from 10AM to 4PM.
