The Navajo Nation Human Rights Commission will be hosting public hearings to assess treatment of Navajo Citizens by law enforcements in border towns.

In 2008, the NNHRC hosted several public hearings that examined race relations between Navajo and non-Navajo citizens; results have shown there is little to no understanding of Navajo culture by border town law enforcements.
